DEI CURRICULUM

Through collaboration with grade-level deans and the assistant director of middle and upper school, we are working to not just react to the needs that arise for our students, but to proactively teach DEI (diversity, equity, and inclusion) skills to help reduce harm. Our scaffolded DEI curriculum will engage students in exploring their identities, bias, and intersectionality. Each month students will work with their advisory group on one of these themes.

From our annual Social Justice Day to curricular units, equity, justice, and inclusion are embedded in all that we do.
