

## What is Opportunity K?

Opportunity K is a free, early entry kindergarten program designed to support children who have not been able to access early childhood programming. Our students are those who have demonstrated a need for an extended kindergarten experience to prepare them for kindergarten in the fall.

## Can my child attend Opportunity K?

Opportunity K is designed to serve students who:

- Turn five by August 31st, 2022 and plan to attend Kindergarten in the fall
- Are not currently in an early childhood program
- Demonstrates a need for support in academics, social/emotional, or language development

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## What do I need to do to apply for Opportunity K?

- Fill out the Opportunity K application, by December 31<sup>st</sup>
- Complete the Opportunity K Parent Questionnaire
- Bring your child to a scheduled screening.

The Opportunity K classroom will be located at the B-E District Office. The program will run February 1<sup>st</sup> through the end of the school year.
