SUBJECT: OAK GROVE SCHOOL DISTRICT CONTINUES TO OUTPERFORM THE STATE

Students in the Oak Grove School District (OGSD) continue to outperform the state in English and Math according to recently released results from the 2019 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP). As a district, our rate of growth in ELA is four times that of the county and state since 2016. Our rate of growth in math is three times that of the county and two times that of the state. The exams are administered to all 3-8th grade students each year in the areas of Mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA).

- In Math, 48% of Oak Grove students are meeting or exceeding the Math Standards. This represents a 2% increase from 2017-18. Our overall math results exceeded the state by 8%.
- All grade levels showed a maintenance or increase in math results from 2018. Grade 5 showed the highest growth with a 6% increase. Grade 3 showed a 5% increase from 2018.
- Our African American students demonstrated at 4% increase in math from 2018. Our results for African American students exceeds the state by 9%.
- In ELA, 54% of OGSD students met or exceeded standards. This represents steady maintenence from 2017-18. Our overall ELA results exceeded the state by 3% and outperforms the state for four student groups: African American, Filipino, White and Reclassified Fluent English Proficient Students (RFEP).
- Grades 6 and 7 showed an increase in ELA results in comparison to 2018. By cohort, our grade 7 students showed an increase of 4% when tested in grade 8.
- Our reclassified fluent English proficient students (RFEP) continue to achieve at high levels on state summative tests with 71% meeting or exceeding standards in math and 79% in ELA. Their achievement outperforms the state by 19% in ELA and 31% in math.

Superintendent, José Manzo is impressed with students' rate of growth in comparison to the state and county. "I am proud of our teachers, students and all staff playing a role in the education of our students. We continue to outperform the State, which is a testament to the quality instruction and programs we provide in Oak Grove."
