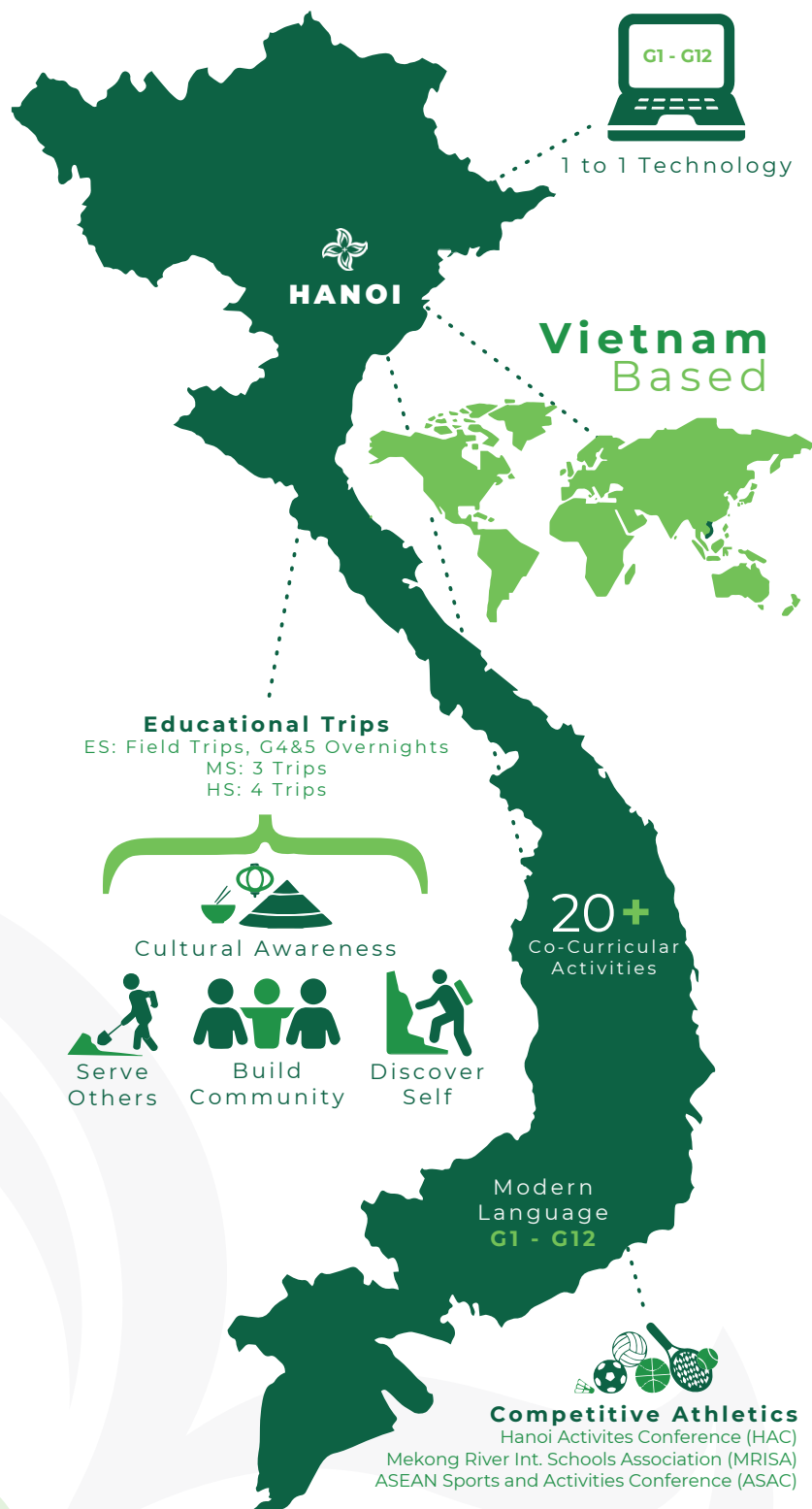




Our Philosophy

Academic Program

Concordia International School Hanoi offers a rigorous, college preparatory curriculum based on American standards and benchmarks. All instruction is in English with the exception of world languages. Students are assigned to the EAL program when their demonstrated English skills are one grade or lower than their age/school grade. When an EAL student completes EAL, they are then eligible to enroll in one of the World Language classes. In addition to classes taught on campus, students have the option to enroll in online courses with accredited schools. In Fall 2016, Concordia began offering Advanced Placement (AP) courses on campus.

Course Explanations

Over the past four years, the range of course offerings available at Concordia International School has increased as the student population has grown. Please see the explanations below for further information on recent additions to our program.

MVLA (Multivariable Calculus and Linear Algebra)

Multivariable Calculus and Linear Algebra are advanced math courses that extend beyond the scope of the AP mathematics curriculum and are offered to Concordia students as dual enrollment courses through Concordia University Nebraska.

Robotics and Engineering, and STEAM Lab

Robotics and STEAM lab are design and technology courses that explore automation solutions using VEX robotics, Arduino, and other design tech platforms.

Applied Learning Labs

Applied Learning Labs offer students intense study of particular interest, developing new knowledge and contributing to the relevant discipline. Students may conduct a research project, with the goal of submitting a conference paper or paper for journal publication. Students may also develop and host an art show, direct a movie or play, produce a film, or other such knowledge production activities in a focused area of study.

Health and Wellness

The Concordia wellness program encourages students to develop a healthy lifestyle, and develop strategies for students to cope with academic rigors and life challenges. The program combines physical, emotional, social, university and career, and life wellness components to facilitate the development of the whole student.

Credits Required for Graduation

Graduation from Concordia (grades 9-12) requires the completion of the following high school course credits:

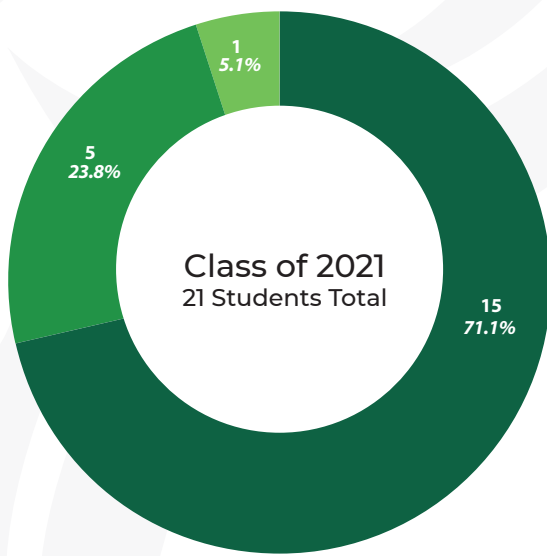

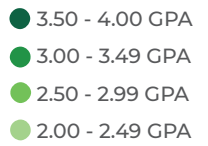
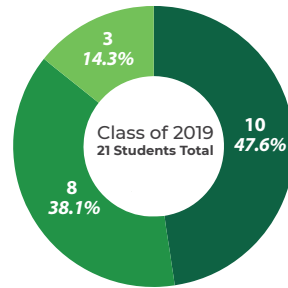
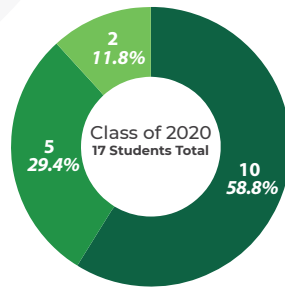
** Students must complete Algebra 2 as the minimum requirement for mathematics

Class Rank & Grading Scale

- Concordia uses a 4.0 grading scale.
- Only coursework completed at Concordia is used in the calculation of a student's GPA.
- Concordia does not weight grades for AP, honors, or dual credit courses. Students who meet the prerequisites can take AP and/or dual credit classes.
- Due to the highly accomplished nature of the Concordia student body and the mobility of expatriate families, an individual's class rank is not reported.

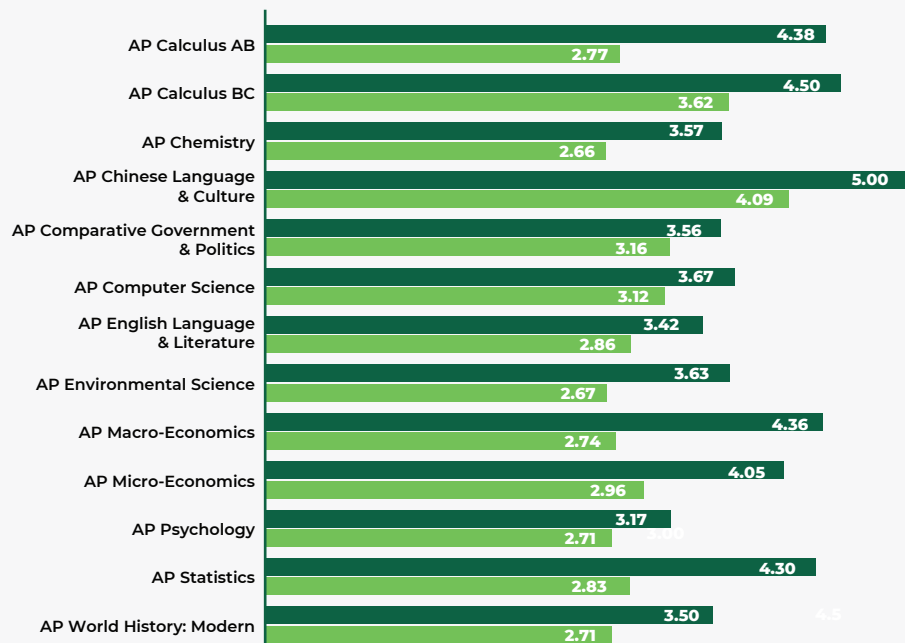

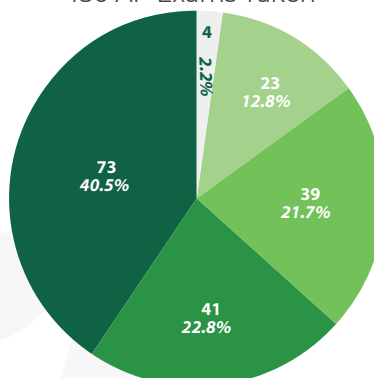

SAT Mean Score Comparison

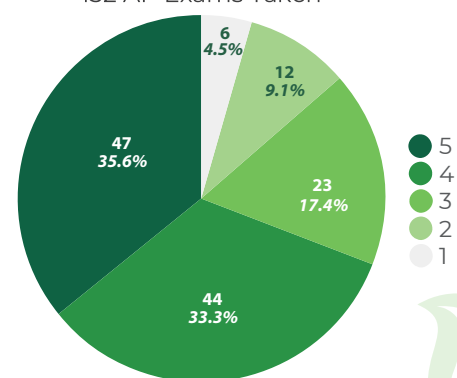
