## Spring Festival Concert

All pupils in Upper School take part in this concert. In the weeks leading up to half term, auditions are held with every child playing a solo or in a small group to their peers. Secret votes are cast for which act will go on to perform in front of the whole school. As well as the solos each year group choir performs two songs. It is a hugely popular event and generates tremendous excitement and enthusiasm.

## Middle School Concerts

At the start of the Spring term this concert provides an opportunity for the potential music and drama scholars to perform their pieces to an audience, in preparation for their auditions.

## Picnic Concert

Every two years we have a spectacular outside concert where families can enjoy the wonderful music making of the children in the beautiful surroundings of the Rose Garden. Along with the performances the picnic interval is enjoyed by everyone and this event it is a highlight of the calendar.

In the alternate year from the Picnic Concert we put on our glam rock rags and the Barn is turned into the hippest venue around for "St Hugh's Rocks!"

## **Musical Productions**

Each Spring term we put on a large scale musical production with the children in Year 7 in conjunction with the Drama Department. We have produced 'Oliver', 'Joseph', The Sound of Music and 'The Wizard of Oz' in recent years, to great acclaim, and much loved by the children taking part.

The summer term is the time for a Middle School musical production. On a smaller scale from the spectacular event in Year 7, it introduces the younger children to the genre and gives them a taste of things to come.
