~~1. PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY~~

~~The Board of Education of the Davis School District (Board) is authorized by Utah Code Ann. Title 53G, Chapter 5 Charter Schools to sponsor charters for charter schools operating within the geographical boundaries of the Davis School District. Although the Board is conceptually supportive of the positive experimentation and innovation which may be associated with charter schools, the Board is cognizant of its responsibilities to provide ongoing oversight, evaluation, and intervention if necessary, for charter schools when it has exercised its chartering authority. The Board will therefore consider charter schools, subject to the requirements established in Utah State law and administrative code and accept the associated regulatory responsibilities for schools over which the District would retain operational authority. All other applications will be referred to the State Charter School Board for consideration.~~

Revised: October 21, 2008 - Technical changes to comply with administrative code.

Revised: September 1, 2009 - No content change, renumbered from 4I-103 to 4I-104 with reorganization of the Policy Table of Contents.

Revised: July 13, 2010 - Technical changes to comply with State law and administrative code. Modified procedures for admitting students to charter schools and transferring from a charter school to a school district or another charter school.

Revised: August 2, 2011 - Repealed and replaced with a more general policy. Extensive policy language required frequent updates as the laws related to Charter Schools are continually evolving.

Revised: July 12, 2016 - Five-year review. No changes.

March 8, 2018 – Education code references updated in accordance with 2018 recodification.
