## Grandview Elementary School is a School-Wide Title I School

### What is School-Wide Title I?

A school-wide program (SWP) is a comprehensive reform strategy designed to upgrade the entire educational program in a Title I school; its primary goal is to ensure that all students, particularly those who are low-achieving, demonstrate proficient and advanced levels of achievement on State academic achievement standards.

### Who benefits from Title I?

\*Every child at Grandview may benefit from Title I services.

\*If your child needs extra help at any time, they may receive services from a Title I Educational Assistant.

\*If a child is not making progress as we monitor them with Acadience, reading assessments, grades, and PSSA scores, it may be determined they can receive additional support with a Reading Specialist or with our SIS (Student Intervention Specialist). They are given more support to break the “code” of reading to help them be successful.

\*If your child is receiving services from one of our reading specialists or SIS, you will be notified and your child’s progress will be shared as we work together as a team to ensure your child’s success.

\*With Title I funds every child in the school receives additional resources, books, and materials.

### How does Title I get families involved?

\*Families can enjoy some evening events planned throughout the year: A Night with Santa, Math Night, and Barnes & Noble Night.

\*You can also be a part of our Title I committee that meets throughout the year. If you would like to be on our committee or volunteer for our Title I events, please let us know.
