#### **Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum (KS:CPC)**

The KS:CPC teaches children and young people to recognise abuse, tell a trusted adult, understand what is appropriate and inappropriate touching and ways of keeping themselves safe.

For Years R-2, the following topics are covered:


