- IX. Council Delegate's Report Kelly Clark, Rosann Redd, Nikky Freeman
 - 1. Dr. Ryba spoke about the focus of this year. Multi-Tiered Systems of Support is broken down into 3 tiers. Tier 1 reaches 85% of learners, tier 2 is small groups that need a little extra help and tier 3 are the students on IEPs. The district is focusing on Tier 1 to get the teachers to teach and assess students in the same way and collaborating to capture more students in the tier 1 group. In turn, reducing the students needing the tiers 2 and 3 support.
 - 2. District will continue to focus on PBIS
 - 3. To stay a premier district, there will be a focus on communication, and technology.
 - 4. COVID patterns will continue to be watched and needs addressed as the environment changes.
 - 5. Levy renewal on the ballot in November. Not a new tax and Esser funds cannot be used to cover costs supported by the Levy. Council voted to approve supporting the levy renewal.
