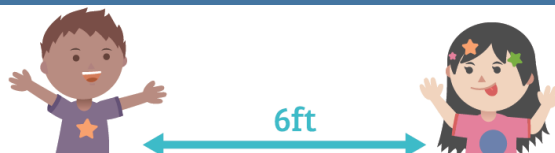


Low Exposure Notification

Any time an individual who is COVID-19 positive is on a school site, you will receive a Low Exposure notification. This notification is given to aid individuals in monitoring any symptoms for 14 days from the last possible exposure date.



COVID-19 Student Close Contacts

A **CLOSE CONTACT** is defined as an individual which came within 6 feet of a COVID-19 positive individual for 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour cumulative period of time.



Asymptomatic & Vaccinated

Consistently Masked /
Inconsistent Masking

- No Quarantine Required
- No required testing (CDC recommends to test between day 3 and 5)
- Monitor for symptoms through day 14



Asymptomatic & Unvaccinated

Inconsistent Masking

- Home Quarantine Required (2 options)
 - 7 day with a negative test on day 6 or 7
 - 10 day quarantine no testing required
- Monitor for symptoms through day 14
- Quarantine from extracurriculars and community events for 14 days



Symptomatic

Consistently Masked /
Inconsistent Masking

- 10 day isolation required regardless of test result (due to symptoms and close contact)
- Student should get tested
- Student should get care



Asymptomatic & Unvaccinated

Consistently Masked

- Two Quarantine Options
 - Modified: school exposure only, continue attending school, masked indoor and outdoor, negative test every 3 days
 - 10 day home quarantine no testing required
- Monitor for symptoms through day 14
- Quarantine from extracurriculars and community events for 14 days
