



## Assets School Athletics-Sign up today!

Dear Parents and Student-Athletes:

Participation in interscholastic sports at Assets School is a great way to have fun, broaden experiences, and make new friends. After a year full of uncertainty and cancellations, Assets School Athletics is excited to get "Back in the Game" for the 2021- 2022 School year!

**Students in grades 7-12 may try out for interscholastic sports.** There are 18 sports to choose from that are offered at three levels of competition, depending on the student's grade and skill level: Intermediate-

- grades 7-9
- Junior Varsity- grades 9-11
- Varsity-grades 9-12

### **There are also three kinds of teams at Assets:**

- PAC-5 Team - Assets students and students from other small ILH schools
- Combined Team- Assets students and students from another ILH school
- Assets Team – All Assets students and Assets coaches

PAC-5 and Combined Team tryouts are competitive, and the goals on these teams are determined by PAC-5 and the other schools. For example, if your child has no experience in football, trying out for the interscholastic team would not be prudent. Some competitive experience is necessary.

Most teams practice five days a week. This commitment is a firm expectation for successful participation in athletics. In order to meet this commitment, students are discouraged from participating in other activities which would limit their commitment during their sport season. Starting practice/tryout dates for Fall sports may begin mid-July. Please check the Athletic Calendar on our website for the start date of all sports-Fall, Winter and Spring.

### **Participation Fees:**

To offset some of our athletic program expenses, we charge a one-time athletic participation fee of \$275 per student-athlete per year. This is a flat fee regardless of the number of sports a student participates in during the school year. Once your child has made the team, the participation fee is due and will be charged to your FACTS account. Please do not send payment to Assets. This fee is non-refundable.

Transportation costs have increased substantially in the past few years. Our Administration is looking at various options to transport students to sporting events, and there may be a nominal fee for transportation for each sport season.

### **Forms Required:**

In order for your child to participate in any athletic sport at Assets School, the following forms must be completed and returned to me by the deadlines specified below. The Student Participation form and the Annual Physical Form are due prior to the first day of practice. **The links for the forms are located below this letter on our website.**

#### **2. Student participation and Parent/Guardian Approval/Emergency Information**

Medical insurance coverage (including policy number) is a requirement of the Hawaii High School Athletic Association (HHSAA). A student accident insurance plan can be purchased if there is no medical coverage. Please call the athletic office for details.

#### **3. Annual Physical Examination for Athletes- Pre-Participation Evaluation form**

(two-sided) must be completed and dated by a qualified physician.

Students may NOT participate until the physical form is ON FILE in the Athletic Director's office.
