**Position Title:** Assistant Professor of Public Health/Associate Professor of Public Health

**Position Location:** Wingate Main Campus

The Department of Public Health at Wingate University invites applications for a security-track position commencing in August 2022. The successful candidate will be one of the inaugural principal faculty members of the Department of Public Health which enrolled students in Fall 2021. In a security-track position, one is considered for professional security after six years of successful teaching.

The successful candidate will be a team-oriented public health professional who can contribute to (a) curricular design, (b) teach a variety of undergraduate and graduate public health courses, and (c) advise both undergraduate and graduate public health students. The teaching expectation will be four courses per semester. Further, the successful candidate will engage in scholarship activities, facilitate community engagement with partners, and provide service to the university and profession. Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The Department of Public Health at Wingate University offers degree programs for a Bachelor of Science in Public Health (BSPH) and Master of Public Health (MPH). The program also offers unique degree tracks including a 4 +1 year BSPH - MPH degree and plans to offer future dual MPH degree options. Accreditation with SACSCOC was successfully obtained in the summer of 2021. The BSPH degree is an in-person residential academic program and the MPH degree is an online asynchronous/ synchronous program.

**Qualifications and Experience**

- Doctoral degree in public health, health education, or a closely-related field at time of effective date of appointment required.
- Evidence of successful college teaching experience in a public health, health education, or closely-related curriculum required.
- Demonstrated potential to develop a research initiative in a public health discipline required.
- Demonstrated potential to provide on-going service to the department, community, university and profession required.
- Doctoral degree in public health, OR a Master's degree in public health (MPH) with a Doctorate health science degree (e.g., MD, PharmD, DPT, etc.) preferred.

- Evidence of successful community engagement, including the ability to foster formal partnerships with health and community-related organizations preferred.
- Experience with public health curricular design and CEPH accreditation efforts preferred.
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively within academia preferred.
- Experience with facilitating online education preferred.
- Successful research and grant activity preferred.
- Previous public health/health education work experience preferred.
- Credentialed in CHES, MCHES and/or CPH preferred.
- Previous healthcare management experience preferred.
