### **ACE Club Descriptions**

**Morning ACE:** students who arrive early to school are encouraged to sign up for Morning ACE! If you're interested in having a space to play games, draw, create, read, or work on homework then this is the place to be! | *6-12<sup>th</sup> grade students*

Students will participate in local and national chapter activities. | *11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students must apply to be in this club*

**Pom-Squad:** This is the 2021-2022 Northside cheer/dance team. Pom-squad is in collaboration with Northside's Athletics Department. Athletes on this team are responsible for bringing school spirit to all games, assemblies, and student activities. *Students must try-out to be on team* | *8-12<sup>th</sup> grade students*
