Our Strategic Plan is rooted in our Mission and Vision. This plan is a foundation of our action plan which will provide a road map for our work together as a school over the next three years.


THE PROCESS

The Strategic Planning Committee was formed for the 2018-2019 school year. The committee initiated a process that engaged all stakeholders: students, parents, faculty and staff, and board members. The committee sought input on the direction that stakeholders envisaged for the school. This focus originated at the Board retreat in November 2018. The committee met regularly throughout the academic year and was advised by members of faculty and administration. The ISPS Board approved the ISPS Strategic Plan in September 2019. The Strategic Planning Committee will monitor the implementation of the plan, and The ISPS Board will review the progress on the plan annually.









GOAL 1:

ISPS will be a world-class international school (PYP, MYP and DP and/ or AP) that offers students a globally transferable education.

Striving for Excellence

1.1 ISPS continues to implement PYP, MYP and AP at an internationally recognized level.

Sub-Objective 1.1.1: ISPS improves organizational effectiveness and performance to advance and support student learning.

Sub-objective 1.1.2: ISPS students consistently score above International and US norms as measured by MAP, ERB, PSAT, SAT scores and any additional standardized tests.

Sub-objective 1.1.3: 70% of ISPS students (grade 1-9) consistently meet individual target growth goals as measured by MAP scores.

Sub-objective 1.1.4: ISPS maintains differentiated instruction for all students, while offering additional opportunities for advanced students and those with learning differences.

Sub-objective 1.1.5: Leverage technology to offer a wider variety of courses for ISPS students.

1.2 Number of students taking AP courses increases, as does enrollment in AP Capstone, building the academic rigor of ISPS high school.

Sub-objective 1.2.1: ISPS HS students graduate with an average of 6 AP courses.

Sub-objective 1.2.2: ISPS HS maintains an average AP score in all subjects that is above the global average.

Sub-objective 1.2.3: 20% of the class graduate with the AP Capstone Diploma.

1.3 ISPS conducts a feasibility study on the requisites, benefits/ consequences, profitability, and costs of transitioning to a DP program.

Sub-objective 1.3.1: If feasibility study concludes a transition to DP is desirable, Strategic Planning Committee drafts new objective and sub-objectives to prepare for transition.
