- Back page bonus: Once a month we will give you the nursery rhymes being taught in the classrooms. Please recite these nursery ryhmes with your child.
- Tucker's 4K spotlight: We will feature a different classroom throughout the year and give you an inside look at what students are learning at school.

### The Rules Rap

Rap to the Rules in 4K!

The WSD 4K Programs are proud to announce that they have adopted a program-wide model known as the Teaching Pyramid for helping children learn social skills, friendship skills, and appropriate behavior. All of the program staff will be working together to teach your child to make good choices through the following behavior expectations (adapted from Sing along and Read Along with Dr. Jean, The Rules rap, 2007 Dr. Jean Feldman, Creative Teaching Press, Inc.).

#### Follow directions

- Feet and hands to yourself
- Small voices inside, tall voices outside
- Take care of your things
- Work together, be kind and respect each other

When you visit a 4K classroom, you will see the many ways that we will be helping your child learn and practice age-appropriate behavior and social skill expectations. We are excited about this effort and look forward to working with you and your child.

In addition, we will want to work in partnership with you to make sure children can learn to use these expectations at home and in school. You can effectively use the same rules at home. Each week your child's teacher will be sending you tips on how you can help your child learn these expectations and develop social skills and appropriate behavior.

Post the sheet on the refrigerator and use it as a reminder of ways to behave.


