THE TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SEPTEMBER 19, 2021

The St. Ann “APP”: Associate Pastor’s Perspective - Stories abound of the miraculous intercession of Saint Padre Pio of Pietrelcina (Italy), both while he was a Capuchin Franciscan friar and even in the decades following his death in 1968. American soldiers during WWII tell tales of the brown-robed monk who could read their souls as they approached Pio for Confession; a mother about to give birth during a very difficult pregnancy relates the story of how Padre Pio appeared in her hospital delivery room and blessed her even though he was hundreds of miles away and never left the monastery; a local mom who visited the Padre Pio Shrine in South Jersey within the past few years has reported miraculous healings for her son whom doctors declared wouldn’t live more than a few hours after birth.

All of this points to the fact that the saints who have gone before us continue to walk with us on our journey through life. As we know, they pray for us constantly before the Throne of Grace and desire nothing more than our holiness. Pio, Therese of Lisieux and so many other holy women and men promised that once they returned home to the Father, they would be even more attentive to the prayers and cries of those who seek God’s mercy and healing. Perhaps most beautifully, they help us embrace God’s will through their own witness of faithful discipleship.

This week, the Church celebrates Padre Pio’s feast on Thursday, the 23rd. Perhaps one of my favorite quotes/prayers from the holy friar is this one: “My past, O Lord, to Your mercy; my present, to Your love; my future, to Your providence.”

St Pio, pray for us.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation was not offered Saturday September 18th. Instead, Fr. Jasper will hear Confessions on Monday September 20th from 6:30pm-7:30pm in the Church. (Reconciliation will return to Saturdays at 8:30 a.m. on September 25th).

2022 Mass Intentions - We are now accepting Mass requests for the calendar year 2022.

Many of you ask for Masses to be said regularly for deceased loved ones, and some ask that these Masses be offered on specific dates. Your special requests will be honored to the extent possible and we do our best to accommodate you, but we ask for your patience and understanding in this regard. In addition, since it frequently happens that there is more than one request for certain dates and times, it is possible that there will be more than one Intention for a particular Mass.

For the foreseeable future, the Mass times will continue to follow the schedule set to comply with COVID-19 guidelines. All Masses said at St. Ann's will be announced in the bulletin, whether said publicly in the church or said privately by a parish priest.

Scheduling begins in mid-October so it is important that requests be received by October 1, 2021. If you would like to be informed of the dates and times of your scheduled Masses, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope, a phone number or an email address so that we can contact you.

The suggested stipend for each Mass is \$10 and stipends must accompany your requests. Thank you.

FOOD FOR GOD'S HUNGRY CHILDREN. We are collecting canned goods, (bagged food or food in plastic containers too) and dry foods for those who are hungry. Parishioners can leave such food in the marked Knights of Columbus containers in the vestibule of our Saint Ann Church. Foods that are needed include: Powdered/dry milk or milk that does not need refrigeration; Hamburger helper; Green beans; Pasta or Rice; Tuna or other packaged meats in cans or packages; Fruit juice boxed or bottled; and Fruit in cans or packages.

For your convenience, there are reusable plastic bags near the Knights of Columbus containers in the vestibule that you make take to bring food back to SAINT ANN FOOD FOR GOD'S HUNGRY Program.
