CLOTHES / PACKING/ MOBILE PHONES

Pupils should come to school on Monday in home clothes. They should pack a small bag with night gear, a towel, a change of clothes, a waterproof jacket and trousers plus sensible shoes for inside and outside. **A torch, lunch box and water bottle are essential.** Pupils are not required to bring any bedding/sleeping bags as this will be fully provided by the centre. We are away for just over 24 hours and most of the activities will be outside. As is the case with our Third Form Moonrakers week away, pupils are requested not to bring mobile phones as their use often detracts from the learning and social value of the trip. Parents will receive an email/text via Clarion Call to alert you of our safe arrival at the centre on Monday and following our return to School on the Tuesday. Mobile phones brought into School on Monday will be safely locked away in House phone lockers and returned on Tuesday in time for school transport. Please can I also suggest that valuable items are left at home.
