Hello to the East High Community,

I want to address some issues that are causing some conversations in our community. The reason I bring this up is because many of you have expressed how much you want to build up the reputation of East High. I agree with you! These are the types of things I share with our community.

Last week there was a football game that had some unfortunate behaviors from students and adults from both sides. There have been many stories told about the event. I want to state that our athletic director and I were present for the game and were witnesses of everything that happened afterward. I have done a thorough investigation of the game aftermath with the help of witnesses, police officers who were present and the administration of Jan Diego, who were also present. Warranted consequences are happening. We are working with our students, as we always do, to help them learn the types of behaviors that will serve them well as they enter adulthood. Our students make mistakes. We do as well. I am asking all of us to stay positive and keep supporting our school. We are not defined by the actions of a few. See you at the game.

- 4. Enter your student's "Student ID". If you do not know their Student ID, use the LOOKUP STUDENT ID button to access the system.
- 5. Verify the student's birth date (if the system does not accept it, please contact the school to verify if our records or files are correct).
- 6. A list of your student's teachers will be displayed. Check the box next to the name of each teacher(s) you would like to meet with.
- 7. If you have more than one student in the school, you can see all of your students' teachers' schedules at one time by answering YES to this question "Do you want to schedule conferences for another student?" then repeat the steps above for your other students. If you only have one student, answer NO to that question.
- 8. You will then see the available time slots for each teacher you selected.
- 9. Select the times that work best for your schedule.
- 10. Enter your email address (recommended) if you would like an email reminder sent to you. (Your email address is kept private.) The Zoom link for will be included in the Confirmation Email.
- 11. Once you have finished you can confirm your appointment details and print your conference schedule.
- 12. Write down the Confirmation Number (you will need this number to cancel your appointment)




The PSAT/NMSQT will be administered on **Wednesday, October 13th, 2021**, for registered students. Students can register by paying the treasurer \$15 before October 1st.

Students taking the test should meet promptly at **8:45am** on the day of the test in the **EHS Library** with two, No.2 pencils, a school or government-issued ID, an approved calculator, and plan on being there until about **12:45pm**.

PSAT Student Guides should be picked up at the counseling center as soon as possible.

Why take the PSAT/NMSQT? The PSAT/NMSQT stands for the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, which students take as a sophomore or junior. High enough marks on the PSAT/NMSQT are what qualifies students for the National Merit Scholarship.

We would like to invite 12th grade students and parent/guardian to be involved in a College & Career Ready (CCR) meeting with your counselor starting Monday, September 13th.


As part of this meeting, we will discuss educational and career goals, graduation requirements, post-high school plans, and personal concerns, if needed.
