## What do I do if my child was a "close contact"\* of someone who tested positive for COVID-19? - Continued

## If Symptoms Exist

If your child has COVID-19 symptoms, have your child take a PCR, FDA approved Rapid Molecular, or Rapid Antigen test right away. Please note that take-home rapid tests will not be accepted. If no symptoms, have your child test right away and then around Day 5 after their exposure.

#Testing can also be done by your child's healthcare provider or at a free COVID-19 testing site. Find one at sccstayhome.org.

## **Share Results**

Share your child's test results with the school.

## **Isolate if Needed**

Your child must stay home for at least 10 days unless they meet the criteria for a modified quarantine. Talk with your child's school and visit the CDPH website for more information.
