

What do I do if my child was a “close contact”* of someone who tested positive for COVID-19? - Continued

If Symptoms Exist

If your child has COVID-19 symptoms, have your child take a PCR, FDA approved Rapid Molecular, or Rapid Antigen test right away. Please note that take-home rapid tests will not be accepted. If no symptoms, have your child test right away and then around Day 5 after their exposure.

#Testing can also be done by your child's healthcare provider or at a free COVID-19 testing site. Find one at sccstayhome.org.



Share Results

Share your child's test results with the school.



Isolate if Needed

Your child must stay home for at least 10 days unless they meet the criteria for a modified quarantine. Talk with your child's school and visit the [CDPH](https://www.cdph.ca) website for more information.
