

We are proud to share that Madeline Scott, '22 is one of approximately 16,000 Semifinalists in the 67th annual National Merit Scholarship Program. Maddie has earned an opportunity to continue in the competition for some 7,500 National Merit Scholarships worth nearly \$30 million that will be offered next spring.

High school juniors entered the 2022 National Merit Scholarship Program by taking the 2020 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT[®]), which served as an initial screen of program entrants. The nationwide pool of Semifinalists, representing less than 1% of U.S. high school seniors, includes the highest-scoring entrants in each state.



From the approximately 16,000 Semifinalists, about 15,000

are expected to advance to the Finalist level, and in February they will be notified of this designation.

- Thank you for your communication regarding COVID positive cases and those exposed who need to quarantine. These students are eligible for remote learning. I notify all teachers as quickly as possible.
- If your daughter needs assistance in any class, she should speak to her teacher immediately for help. Nazareth Academy also offers peer tutoring through National Honor Society (all subjects except mathematics) and *Mu Alpha Theta* (mathematics).
- Deficiency Reports will be mailed home on September 28. They need to be signed and brought back to school with your daughter and returned to the issuing teacher by October 5. I see all students who receive these reports in my office. Please note that our meetings are pastoral and not punitive. Together, we seek to find a solution to remediate a particular grade.
- Honors and GPA are calculated on the semester and not mid-term grades.
- The close of the Mid-Fall marking period is Friday, October 8.

Transcript Request Form Class of 2022

When your student applies to a college or university, they need to request that their transcript be sent to that particular school. This should be done through the <u>Transcript Request Form</u>. There is a \$3 fee per transcript that is sent. (Example: If your student applies to 5 colleges, then the fee is \$15.)

Instant Decision Days Class of 2022

Nazareth will be hosting an Instant Decision Day with <u>Holy Family University</u> on October 7th. Students who participate will be given an admission decision this day. Students should register by October 1st and complete an application to Holy Family University by October 4th. If your student is interested in registering, please have them fill out this <u>FORM</u>.

Nazareth will be hosting an Instant Decision Day with <u>La Salle University</u> on October 12th. Students who participate will be given an admission decision this day. Students should register for this event and complete an application to La Salle University by October 7th. If your student is interested in registering, please have them fill out this <u>FORM</u>.

Interview Day Class of 2022

Nazareth will be hosting an Interview Day with <u>Saint Joseph's University</u> on October 26th. Students who participate will not be given an admission decision, but they can speak with the admissions representative about their application to Saint Joseph's University, about the university, or about anything else they would like to discuss related to admissions. It is preferred if students apply to Saint Joseph's University before October 26th, but it is not required. Students should register for this event by October 21st by filling out this <u>FORM</u>.
