MUSIC & PERFORMING ARTS

Hello and welcome to music!

My name is Veronica Rotta and I've been involved in the performing arts for over 20 years. I'm so excited to share my passion with your students. Here is an overview of what we will be doing in the coming weeks across the grade levels.

Kindergarten & 1st Grade:

We will explore music through rhythm, dancing, and singing. In our first weeks, we've explored rhythm and how we can use every day sounds to create music.

2nd & 3rd Grade:

We will dive into music through the musical instruments and each student will participate in the "recorder karate" program. Each 2nd and 3rd grade student will be issued their own personal, sanitized recorder that will be stored each week in my room. (They are stored in a covered pouch and students will remove and put away their own recorder.) We will learn and practice our instruments outside, with students spaced at least six feet during practice time.

4th, 5th, & 6th Grade:

We are going to expand students' musical repertoire through learning the ukulele. Our first song all together will be "Lava" from the Pixar Studio short film.

I am so excited to be working with all of your students this year!



ART

3rd Grade

After doing a condensed, advanced version of the states of matter, we moved right into forces of motion! Your students built balloon rockets outside and learned about the laws of motion.

4th-6th Grade

The students competed in the H2Olympics to learn about the properties of water! They worked as a team to conduct experiments, make observations, and share their results.
