

King's A Level Results

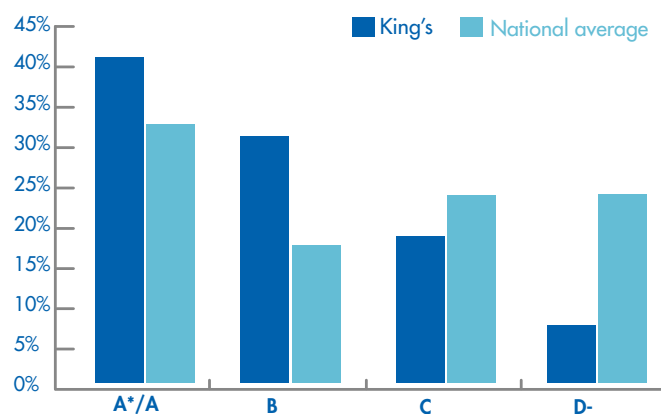

King's students produced another stunning set of A Level results with 41% of all grades at A*/A.

- 41% of all grades A*–A
- 71% of all grades A*–B
- 25 students achieved three A grades or better
- A third of all students achieved A* in at least one subject
- 50% of students are joining Russell Group universities

Headmaster Dr Simon Hyde was incredibly pleased with this year's results: "Results day is always a wonderful occasion, when we celebrate the culmination of two year's hard work. Our talented students have achieved a fantastic set of results, opening doors to their chosen courses and universities, and they too have achieved wonderful sporting, creative and musical successes and



now have the skills and resilience to see them through the next stage of their learning journeys."

In the prestigious Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), which is valued by universities, 75% of all grades are A*/A and 95% at A*–B. Students are going on to study a wide range of courses – from Art and Motorsport Engineering to Medicine and Law – at some of the country's most prestigious institutions including Cambridge, LSE

and Imperial. Nationally, these are the first results of the new 'tougher' linear A Levels introduced two years ago.
