Interview with OM Ed Chudleigh

We recently interviewed OM, Pilot and Inventor, Ed Chudleigh (1993-1996; Shapwick), about his time at Millfield and how it has helped to shape his successful career.

Since leaving Millfield, Ed has designed and invented for Dyson, created Genesis 2 - a machine that can mould all existing types of plastic - and invented the first recyclable face mask!

When asked what advice he would give to students currently at Millfield, Ed said to "never be scared of doing something and it not being successful, because the success is in it failing and what you have learnt to get there."

OM Alison Oliver (1987-1989; Warner) has been awarded an MBE in this year's Queen's Birthday Honours list for all the work she has done for the Youth Sport Trust.

On the 13 November 2020, OM Callum Sheedy (2012-2014; Shapwick) earned his first Welsh Rugby cap, making his international debut in the Autumn Nations Cup. Callum came off the bench for Wales in the opening round against Ireland.

OM Milly Tanner (2013-2017; Martins) has won a silver medal at the UEC European Track Cycling Championships in Plovdiv, as part of The Great Britain Cycling Team. Milly and her trio made up the women's team sprint.

OM Ed Jackson (2002-2007; Walton) has been named as this year's BBC West Unsung Hero! Ed is a recovering quadriplegic, but he has climbed Snowdon, as well as the height of Everest on his stairs at home during lockdown. In the process, he has raised £150,000 for charity, which contributed to him receiving the award.
