

Platte County Health Department Serving Platte County Missouri BTS Immunization Clinic FAQs



Who is eligible for the program? All Middle School students (age 11 and up) and High School students (age 16 and up) who qualify for the Vaccine for Children program (Uninsured, Underinsured, Medicaid, or Native American/Native Alaskan).

Why is it offered? To provide an easier method of getting teens vaccinated for their back to school shots while promoting social distancing measures.

Who is providing the vaccine? The Platte County Health Department.

How much does it cost? The service is free to those who qualify for the Vaccines for Children Program such as those who are uninsured, underinsured, on Medicaid, or are Native American/Native Alaskan.

What Vaccines will be offered? All required & recommended vaccines for your student's age group.

Required

- <u>Tdap</u> (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis) vaccine is required for students entering 8th- 12th grade.
- One Meningococcal/ACWY (Meningitis) vaccine is required for students entering 8th & 9th grade.
- Two Meningococcal/ACWY (Meningitis) vaccines are required for students entering 12th grade.

Recommended

- Hepatitis A
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Meningococcal B (Meningitis) 16 years of age or older.

When & where will the clinics take place? Clinics are being offered on four different dates at two locations.

Platte County Health Department in Platte City, MO

August 5th – 3 pm - 7 pm. Registration due July 27th

August 9th- 9 am - 1 pm. Registration due July 27th

Riverside Fire Department in Riverside, MO

August 19th – 3 pm - 7 pm. Registration due August 10th

August 21st – 9 am - 1 pm. Registration due August 10th

How do I sign up? Parents or legal guardians provide consent by completing the <u>Registration Consent & Screening</u> Form then e-mail the completed forms to <u>client@plattehealth.com</u>. Clerical staff will contact you to schedule an appointment time. Please ensure we have an updated shot record on file.
