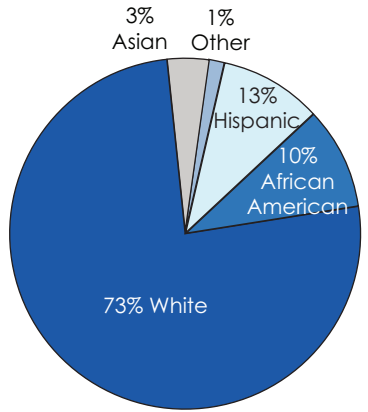

History & Mission

Christian Home and Bible School first opened its doors in 1945, to 55 students. Our mission builds on our legacy of faith and service. We educate, equip, and empower our community to love God and others, pursue excellence, and impact our world. In February of 2015, CH&BS announced the historic name change from Christian Home & Bible School to Mount Dora Christian Academy. Although our name has changed, our mission stays the same. The school now serves 690 students from 2 year olds at the pre-school through 12th grade in the secondary school.

Accreditation

Mount Dora Christian Academy is accredited by Cognia, formerly known as the National Christian School Association and AdvancED. MDCA is also an ACT, PSAT, and CLEP testing site.

Grade Point Average Calculation & Class Rank

Class rank is determined by the GPA semester averages achieved in ALL classroom subjects. Calculations are carried to the fourth decimal place. Any courses taken outside the regular school curriculum must be disclosed at the beginning of each semester. AP and Dual Enrollment classes are weighted by 1 extra point towards GPA and Honors classes are weighted an extra .5 points. Grades, GPA and Class Rank are recorded on the student's transcript at the end of each semester.

Curriculum

All secondary students have 7 classes per day and spend 45 minutes in each class period. Students have the option of taking additional AP courses not offered at Mount Dora Christian Academy through Ethos or Florida Virtual School.
