PSAT

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) and PSAT 10 measure what you're learning in school, determine if you're on track, and open doors for opportunities to prepare and pay for college. This year, the PSAT is being offered to 10th and 11th graders in the LWSD on Wednesday, OCTOBER 13.

Students can check the College Board website to learn more about the test, but it isn't something to "prepare" for, other than getting familiar with the test format. Before the test, schools will be distributing informational booklets provided by the College Board.
