Parent Aware:

Austin Public Schools Community Learning Center Preschool is Four Star Parent Aware rated (highest possible ranking) by the Minnesota Department of Human Services. This rating allows us to offer Pathways Scholarships to qualifying families.

The early childhood years from birth to the start of kindergarten are an important time of rapid learning and growth. Early Childhood Screening is a quick and simple check of how children are doing. It identifies, at an early stage, possible learning or health concerns so that children can get needed help.

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Early Childhood Special Education:

Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) is a program for all children that have been evaluated, meet educational disability criteria and qualify for special education services. ECSE provides services for children from birth through five years of age.

Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten:

Austin Public Schools K-Prep programming is part of Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK), a publicly funded Pre-Kindergarten program. Funded programs provide free, high-quality early childhood education opportunities for eligible 4-year-old children that prepare them for success as they enter Kindergarten the following year.
