

Davis High School Community Council Minutes
April 7, 2021 6:30 a.m.

Attendees: Greg Wilkey, Corine Barney, Tracey Meade, Robyn Lawson, Jared Jensen, Ryan Wilko, Shanna Barker, Julie Call, Brooke Karras, Lance Thaxton, Eliza Thaxton, and Bailey Kohler.

Council Chair Ryan Wilko welcomed the Council and reviewed the previous month's minutes. He motioned that the minutes be accepted. Tracey Meade seconded the motion. The vote to approve the minutes was unanimous and they were approved and adopted.

The Council reviewed the Davis High activity results included in the agenda. A lot of spring sports are happening. Plans are in the works for prom, spirit week, and senior week within District limitations.

Brooke Karras indicated that the PTA is working on a senior all-night part at Boondocks.

Officer Jensen reported there have been some incidents since returning from spring break involving social media.

Dr. Wilkey reviewed recent and year-to-date Trust Lands budget expenditures. Chemistry tutoring exceed budgeted amount by \$142, but it can be covered by areas where expenditures were less than budgeted. No new requests were submitted. The Council reviewed the 2021-2022 proposed goals and budget. One area of particular discussion centered on funding CE Math 1010 and Math 1050 curriculum development. After discussions, Shanna Barker motioned that the proposed goals and budget be approved with communication to the faculty that requests are approved year to year, and that the CE Math 1010 and Math 1050 curriculum development may be a one-time budget request that may be approved for next year only. Lance Thaxton seconded the motion, and the 2021-2022 goals and the 2021-2022 Trust Lands budget were both unanimously approved.

Dr. Wilkey sought approval to hold elections this spring prior to the end of the current school year for next year's vacant Community Council positions. Ryan Wilko motioned to approve. Shanna Barker seconded the motion, and the request was unanimously approved.

No meetings are scheduled for the remainder of the school year. Ryan Wilko motioned that the meeting be adjourned. Julie Call seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 AM.
