The mission of the Austin Public Schools Pyramid Model is to ensure that sustainable, evidence-based practices are used to help young children in our community develop social-emotional skills that increase their likelihood for success across home, school and community settings.

What is Pyramid Model?

The Pyramid Model provides structure and tools so that each child can develop the social and emotional skills that they need to be successful in life.

This is an approach to teaching and supporting positive behavior and meeting the needs of ALL students.

This tiered approach in preschool focuses on building a safe and caring environment in which all students can learn.

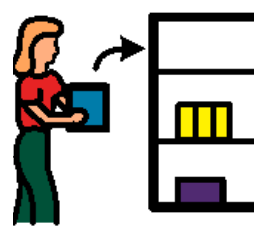


