



Admissions Overview 2021 Intake – June 2021

This data is based on the final applicant list in June 2021 and is based on this year's applications only.

A total of 1394 applications were received for admission to Coombe Wood School for September 2021 intake, this includes 8 Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP) applicants via Croydon Council.

A final intake of 180 has been confirmed according to our admissions criteria and the breakdown is as follows:

Siblings

22 sibling places were offered to pupils this year under our sibling's criteria.

Distance

Of the 31 places offered under the distance criteria, the furthest from the school was **0.643 miles** on National Offer Day.

Health Related Fitness Assessment Applications

264 applications were received for the Health Related Fitness Assessment. All applicants who demonstrated a sporting aptitude were then ranked in order. In 2021 the 18 places reserved for those demonstrating a sporting aptitude were taken by those ranked between **1 to 38**.

The allocation of 18 places was provided within our admissions criteria to enable students who would not have gained a place at the school under any other of the admissions criterion.

Summary Forecast

In 2021, of the 90 places available from our feeder schools, 90 were taken. The number of siblings may increase year on year which will have an additional impact on the 'catchment area' and we therefore expect the current catchment area to decrease.
