

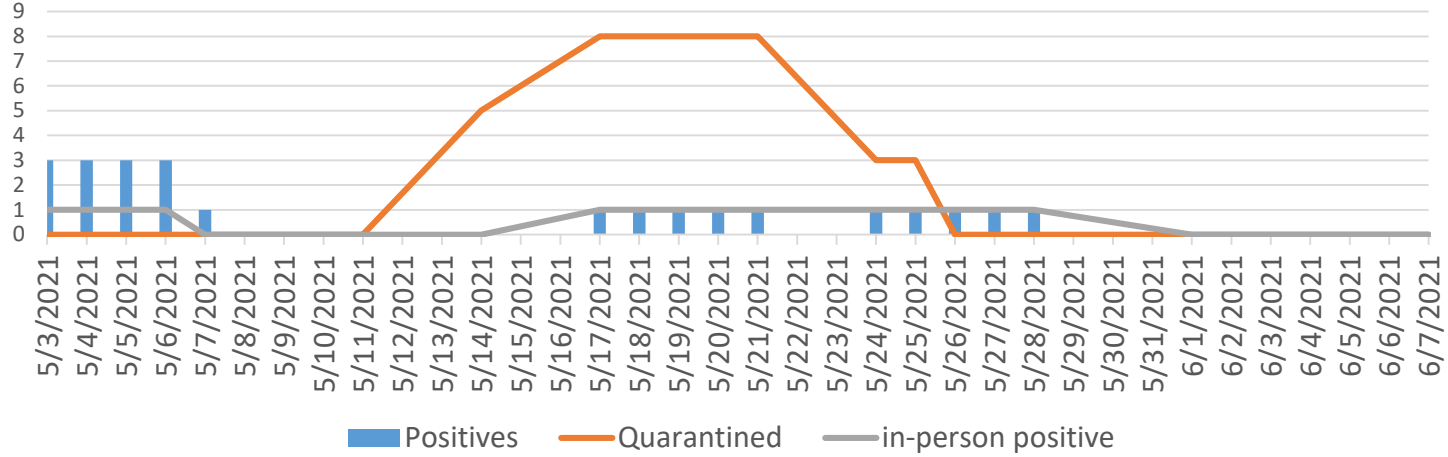

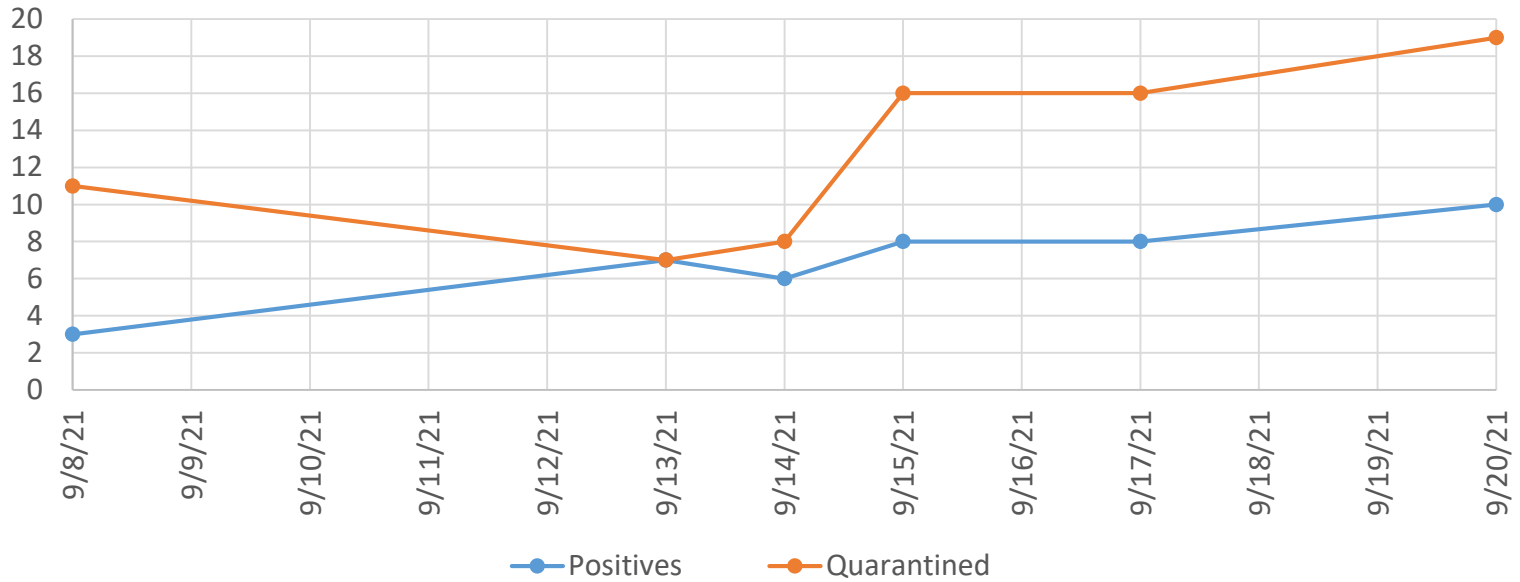

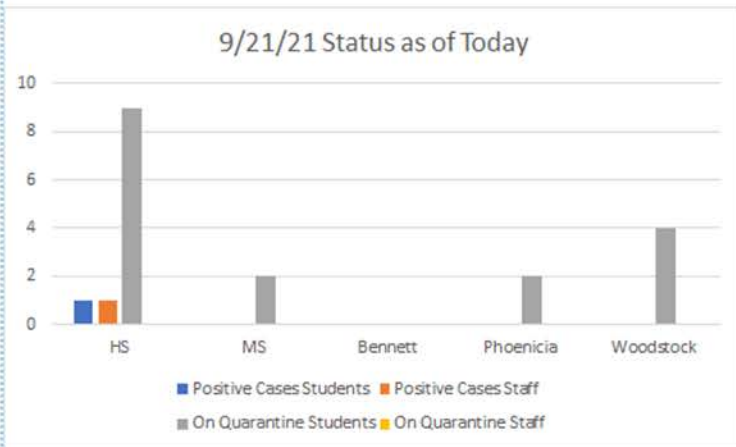

Supporting students out with COVID/ quarantine

We are partnering with parents to work collaboratively and communicate effectively to support the unique needs of students

If a student is out sick due to COVID/quarantine, teachers will utilize Google Classroom to maintain assignments and may use Google Meet, email, and phone calls to communicate with students and parents regarding learning and assignments.

- If students or parents have any questions about this, they should reach out directly to their teacher(s).
- If any further concerns have not been addressed by the teacher:
- K-6 parents: reach out to their building principal.
- 7-12 parents and students: reach out to their child's school counselor and, if needed, the building principal.



Meeting the Mandate

- » District is partnering with Neal Smoller (Village Apothecary) to meet NYS mandated weekly screening test requirements
- » Three District testing sites identified – Phoenicia, Woodstock, Boiceville Campus
- » All staff were surveyed week of 9-13-21
- » Testing is commencing this week @ Phoenicia & Woodstock; next week @ Boiceville campus
- » Initial testing of 166 individuals
- » Expanding testing
 - > All substitutes
 - > Any students whose parent opts-in (target date 10-15-21)
