All senior portraits shall be of the student only with a traditional indoor or outdoor background. No props shall be allowed in the photos. Clothing shall be modest and free of slogans and/or political expressions and shall not include or promote the use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or the use of other items prohibited from use on school grounds. The Scarborough High School yearbook, Four Corners, reserves the right to edit or deny any submitted photo for publication and printing in the book. The advisor and the school administrators will have the final decision on submitted photos based on what they feel is appropriate for a school publication. Likewise, any submitted text will be edited for appropriateness.

ADVERTISEMENTS:

The Scarborough High School yearbook and other publications are not a public forum. Accordingly, any advertisements must be free of political expression and reflect the common values of Scarborough High School. Advertisements shall not promote the use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or the use of other items prohibited from use on school grounds. Parent Ads submitted to the Scarborough High School yearbook will be reviewed and edited by the advisor. The advisor reserves the right to edit or deny any submitted photo for publication and printing in the book. All text submitted may be edited for content and may be refused based upon a determination that it is inappropriate and/or in violation of copyright infringement.

SENIOR MESSAGES:

All senior messages shall be free of personal attacks, abusive language, racial epithets, vulgar comments, sexual innuendo, and all other speech that is inconsistent with the shared community values Scarborough High School. The advisor reserves the right to edit text as deemed necessary.
