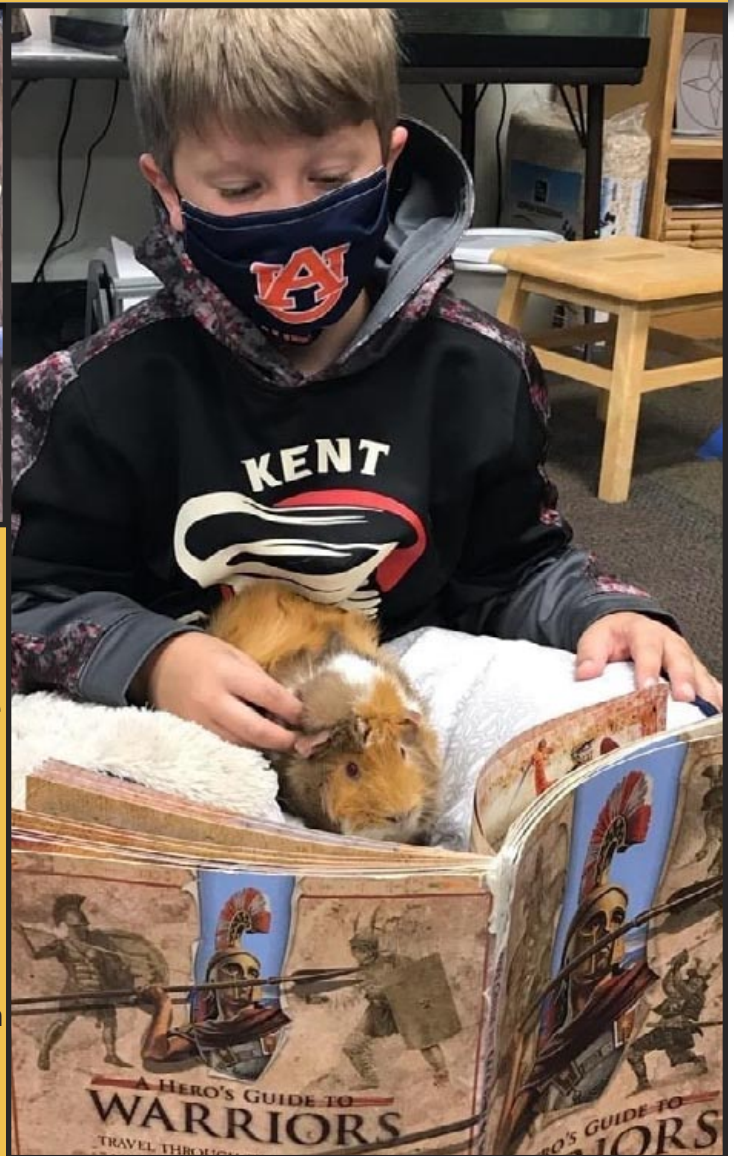

Registrations and Waivers

Registrations and waivers for all After-School Clubs can be downloaded from the HMS website under the "Beyond the Classroom" tab. In addition, payment and registration can also be processed online at <https://www.hudsonmontessori.org/beyond-the-classroom/clubs>.

In the event that a class is full or cancelled, parents will be notified as soon as possible.

Please note on days where one-day clubs and "School's Out" are offered, a discount for enrolling in both a one-day club and "School's Out" day will be offered.

Class Cancellations

If school is closed due to weather or other emergency, class is automatically cancelled. Absences on the part of the child are forfeited; absences on the part of the instructor or contractor will be made up via make-up date, extended time during a future meeting date, or credited. If there is a weather-condition or covid closure, we will reschedule and/or refund the one-day club.

Enrollment

All clubs are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Some clubs fill up quickly. In order for your student to be enrolled, complete all sections of the registration and submit full payment. **Please see each club for its respective registration deadline date.**

Withdrawals and Refunds

If withdrawal from a one-day club occurs a week before the Session begins, a credit will be considered. There are no credits once clubs after that date.

If a written request is made at least seven days prior to the beginning of the club session, a refund can be issued minus a \$15 processing fee. If a one-day club does not meet the minimum enrollment requirements and is cancelled by HMS, a full refund will be issued.

Horsing Around with Veterinarian Ratios

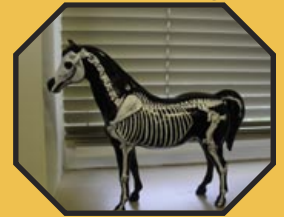
Instructor: Dr. Alyssa McQuait

Akron Zoo Visit

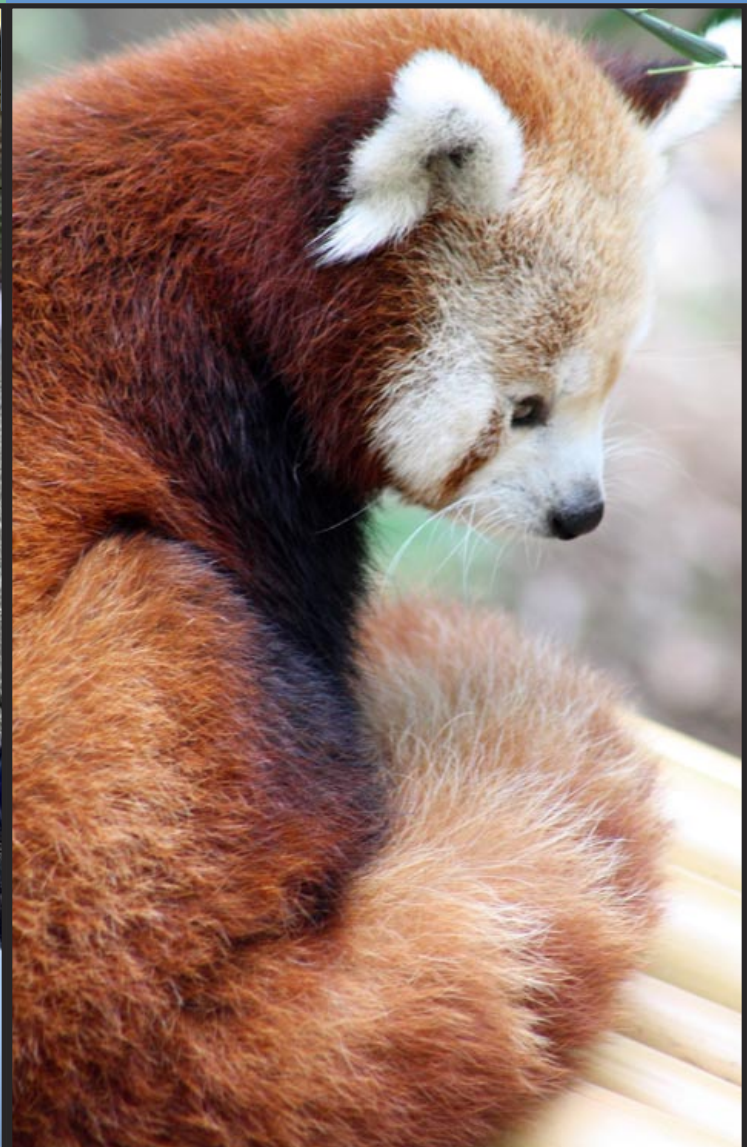
