2021-22 Teacher Induction Program

The New Teacher Induction program is a year-long program that combines mentorship, collaborative learning, and professional development to support new teachers in their practice. The program is open to all teachers who currently hold an Instructional I, Emergency, or Intern certification. All educators are required to complete Induction in order to convert their Instructional I to an Instructional II.
