

Questions to Ask College Representatives

Admissions Questions:

1. What is the most important factor in your admission decision? Grades? Scores? Extracurricular activities?
2. How large is your undergraduate enrollment?
3. What are the middle 50% scores for admission for this year's freshman class?
4. What is Early Decision? What is Early Action? What is Early Admission?
5. Do your students come from all over the country? All over the world? Do you require personal interviews?
6. Do you track demonstrated interest?

Financial Aid Questions:

1. Do you offer financial aid?
2. Do you offer merit scholarships? For what?
3. Do you meet 100% of demonstrated need?
4. Do you have a separate scholarship application from the admissions application?

Campus Life/ Community Life Questions:

1. Describe your campus location. Urban? Suburban? Small town?
2. What resources do your campus provide to ensure safety on campus?
3. Can you talk about diversity initiatives on your campus?
4. Does your campus offer living and learning communities for people who have similar identities or interests similar to mine (e.g., LGBTQ, honors, community service)?
5. What does campus housing look like?

Academic/ Major Questions:

1. Do you offer my major? When do I have to confirm/declare what my major is?
2. What academic support services are available (e.g., advising, disability service, tutoring)?
3. Is there a required core of classes I have to take to graduate?
4. Is there a Career Planning Office? What services does it offer?
5. What is the student/faculty Ratio?

How to follow-up Questions:

1. How do I get more information about your school?
2. How do I get on the mail list?
3. Do you offer tours and information sessions?
