SUBJECT English Language

Course Breakdown

We use the AQA exam board which consists of two exam papers, both equally weighted at 50%.

Section A of both papers asks the student to look at unseen extracts ranging from the 18th-21st century and identify language and structural devices that the writers have used and comment on the effect of this.

Section B of both papers asks students to write a creative piece, either a description of a picture or to argue and persuade on a specific topic.

Revision Resources

Revision Strategies

As Language is an unseen paper, the main revision need for the students is memory recall. They need to ensure that they know their language devices, structural devices and persuasive devices. Alongside this, they need to ensure they know how to answer each of the questions.
