OVERVIEW | Established in 1983, NCCS is an independent, interdenominational, college preparatory Christian school located on a 56-acre campus northwest of Atlanta, GA. NCCS serves over 1,000 students in PK3-12th from 10 countries, with nearly 400 students in grades 9-12.

ADMISSIONS | Students are accepted on the basis of entrance exams, academic performance at previous schools, family / student interviews, and standardized test scores. Students are admitted from all race, color, ethnic, and national origins and are bound by the NCCS Honor Code and Statement of Faith.

NCCS is dual accredited by Cognia (formerly AdvancEd) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). NCCS is a member of NACAC and SACAC.

COVID-19 IMPACT

NCCS believes that student learning and demonstration of mastery are optimal via in-person instruction. Thus, the school has maintained in-person learning through the 2020-2021 school year.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The NCCS school year is comprised of two semesters of approximately 18 weeks each. Classes are taught on a modified block schedule, with most classes meeting every other day for 90-minutes. Upper School students typically enroll in eight classes.

Honors courses received an additional 0.5 quality point, and AP and Dual Enrollment receive an extra 1.0 quality point. Numeric grades on transcripts are unweighted grades earned by the student.

ADVANCED COURSE OFFERINGS 2021-2022

NCCS offers 14 Advanced Placement (AP) courses, 8 Dual Enrollment (DE) college courses and 20 Honors courses. AP courses not offered can be taken online with approval. NCCS offers 8 Dual Enrollment courses on campus through NCCS teachers who are credentialed by Shorter University and Truett McConnell University.

Students can graduate with a maximum of 25 hours through this partnership. Eligible students can be approved to take additional Dual Enrollment courses through the University System of Georgia. Dual Enrollment courses are typically taken during senior year and limited to three dual enrollment courses per semester.

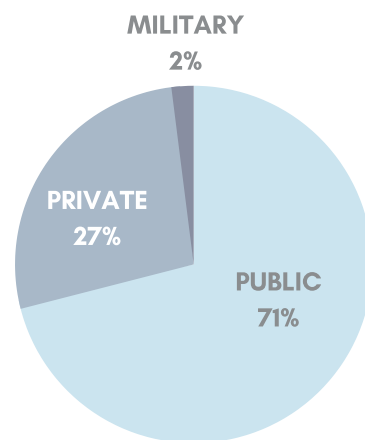
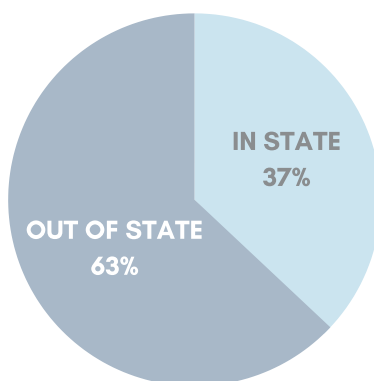
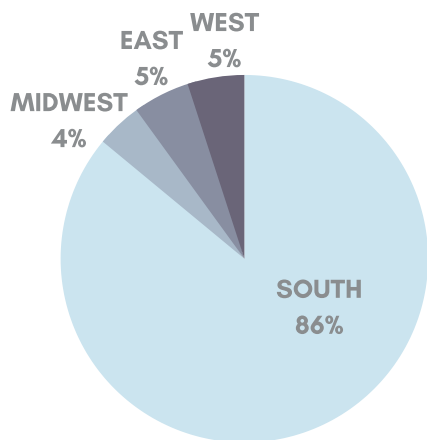

CLASS OF 2021 ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

100 percent of the NCCS Class of 2021 was admitted to a college or university. These 85 graduates enrolled in 55 different universities, including 17 Christian colleges and universities. Students were awarded over \$6.5 million in academic, athletic, talent and leadership scholarships, not including the Georgia Hope Scholarship and Zell Miller Scholarship.

ATHLETICS

NCCS fields 52 teams in 20 sports. NCCS Athletics has won two national championship team titles in two sports, seven runner-up national championship titles in five sports, 11 state championship team titles in five sports, 14 state championship individual titles in three sports, and 30 regional championship titles in seven sports.

FINE ARTS

The Arts at NCCS is consistently recognized by interscholastic governing bodies as a program of excellence. Supporting 17 performing ensembles, the Arts programs have won 20 regional championships in GHSA One Act and Literary categories and 12 state championships in One Act, Boy's Solo, Girl's Solo, Trio and Quartet. The Georgia High School Musical Theatre Shuler Hensley Awards has recognized NCCS with two Shuler awards, six nominations and multiple honorable mentions. Instrumental and vocal ensembles receive superior ratings at all GMEA competitions.

STUDENT LIFE

North Cobb Christian School fosters the formation of the whole student, from strong academic, athletic and artistic foundations to solid social and spiritual development. The NCCS Student Life program creates environments to worship, serve and grow in Christ, including weekly chapel, annual fall retreat, regular community service opportunities, small group discipleship through Advisory Groups, annual Spring Term mission-based service trips around the world, and school traditions such as Circle of Prayer and Spiritual Emphasis Week. Students' lives are forever changed through Student Life at NCCS.



THE NCCS ACADEMIES

The NCCS Academies are equivalent to magnet programs, providing a rigorous academic and real-world foundation in one of five tracks, which students can select: Business; STEM; The Arts; Exercise and Sports Science; and Counseling, Ministry and Education.

THE ACADEMY OF BUSINESS

Through designated classes, internships, and exposure to corporate arenas, the Academy of Business prepares students to become innovators and thought leaders in the realm of business.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS | Accounting, Finance, Law, Marketing, Managing and Leading in the Global Economy, Personal Finance, Internship

THE STEM ACADEMY

This rigorous program prepares students to pursue advanced degrees and careers in science, technology, engineering and mathematics. Program milestones include a research course sophomore year, an internship junior year, and a capstone project senior year.

THE ACADEMY OF THE ARTS

With options in Visual Arts, Vocal Arts, Instrumental Arts and Theatrical Arts, students must pass an audition to join the Academy of the Arts, where they glean formal instruction, real-world context, and next-level performance experiences.

THE ACADEMY OF EXERCISE AND SPORTS SCIENCE

Designed for students interested in sports management and athletic-related careers, the course of study covers the business aspects and the healthcare side of fitness professions. Students glean foundational knowledge and exposure to take them to the next level.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS: Sports Management, Accounting, Healthcare Science, Athletic Training, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology, Law, and Internship

THE ACADEMY OF COUNSELING, MINISTRY AND EDUCATION (ACME)

ACME provides a biblical foundation while equipping students with knowledge of human functions, thoughts and behaviors (psychology); the impact on society (sociology); and foundational beliefs (philosophy). Students investigate foundations, methodologies and opportunities in people-oriented fields. **COURSE REQUIREMENTS:** Psychology, Sociology, Advanced Counseling, Ministry, and Education, Teacher Cadet, and Internship
