





HOLIDAY SHOPPING – According to an article in a recent issue of Kiplinger's Retirement Report, holiday shoppers may give the mall a pass. As the pandemic eases, many consumers are in no hurry to wrangle over parking spaces or stand in long lines at the mall. While some might consider these inconveniences or simply annoying, older people find them difficult. Most of us know those Black Friday deals can be found just as easily online. Some major retailers have taken note and plan to close stores on Thanksgiving when e-commerce sales are expected to surge 50% this year! Retailers plan sales with an eye on shipping. Some may extend sales for longer periods, especially if shipping delays continue. A large number of imports could further strain transpacific shipping capacity before the holidays. Just last week, I heard a report that holiday shopping could begin as early as the end of September because consumers are worried supplies are running short and long delivery times. While it seems that every year we see Christmas decorations showing up earlier and earlier in the malls, there's no telling what this year will bring! Maybe this is the year we should slow down, simplify, and focus on the reason for the Season!

FIVE STEPS TO CHOOSING A NURSING HOME - Having to choose a nursing home is fraught with confusion and fear. Families are often given little time and guidance to make an informed choice. Before a health crisis, create a list of places you'd be willing to consider. A geriatric care manager can often recommend facilities and coordinate the transition. You can go to medicare.gov/care-compare for nursing homes certified by Medicare and Medicaid, which most are. They're rated for overall care with one to five starts based on health inspections, staffing levels, and evaluation measures. Step 1 is to check overall rating on care-compare, and Step 2 requires you to filter those for staffing ratings. Step 3 involves your review of complaints and deficiencies for your top 3 picks, and Step 4 involves the availability of a bed being available when needed. Finally, Step 5 requires a tour and getting questions answered. Considering the financial side of things, it's advisable to read "Your Guide to Choosing a Nursing Home or Other Long Term Services & Supports" by going to medicare.gov/pub/popular-medicare-publications. A geriatric care manager who belongs to the Aging Life Care Association can find and coordinate care for patients. They know the reputations of facilities and can be most helpful. Their fees range according to the region in which you live.
