TOP EXAM RESULTS

57% of all AL results achieved an A* or A grade and 57% of GSCEs scored a 9-7 grade. In the IB Diploma, the average score was 37, with 12 students achieving 40 points or more. The majority go on to study at leading universities including Oxbridge, Russell Group and top universities in the UK and overseas. Others secure competitive degree apprenticeships or direct workplace employment.

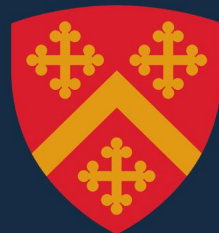
