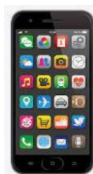

### October Family Night

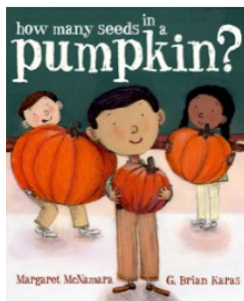

## WSD COVID GUIDELINES 21-22

**Students must stay home from school if they have the following symptoms.**

<b>One</b> of these symptoms:	<b>Two</b> or more of these symptoms:

- If a student has symptoms, it is recommended that they immediately be tested for COVID, regardless of vaccine status.
- The student may return to school with proof of a negative **PCR** COVID test or an alternate diagnosis from a medical practitioner.
- If parents choose not to have their child tested, the student is presumed positive and must stay home for 10 days, be fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication, and have improvement of symptoms before returning to school.
- If a student or anyone else living in the home tests positive, all students in the home (unless vaccinated and not showing symptoms) must quarantine for the 10 days of the positive person's isolation PLUS an additional 10 days quarantine, a total of 20 days. If the positive person can isolate away from the students, the other students in the home must quarantine for 10 days from the last contact with the positive person.
- Parents are asked to notify the school if a student later develops symptoms or tests positive for COVID.
- If your child is identified as a close contact to someone outside the home, follow the directions from the health department.

## Lumberjack Basketball

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Included is a registration form for the 2021-2022 **Junior Jax Basketball Program**. The main goal of the Junior Jax Program is to get Eastside boys in grades 3 – 8 excited about and passionate for the game of basketball.

Each Saturday, participants will have the opportunity to work with the high school coaching staff, as well as high school players. In addition, the Traveling Team coaches will also be a part of the program, to help both the players and Traveling Team coaches become a cohesive group working toward a common goal.

In addition to the Saturday morning Junior Jax Program, we also have **Traveling Teams for grades 3 thru 8**. Teams will practice twice a week throughout November and December. Tournaments for grades 4, 5 and 6 will be on Saturdays throughout January & February. Practices will also continue twice a week throughout January & February. **There will be an informational meeting about Traveling Basketball for parents of 3rd, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade players on two dates. Saturday, November 6<sup>th</sup> at 8:15 AM at Wausau East.** This is the same day as the first Junior Jax session. **There will also be a meeting on Saturday, November 13<sup>th</sup> at Wausau East during the second Jr Jax session.** A parent/guardian needs to attend one of the meetings if their son is playing on the Traveling Team at his grade level. There will be a **separate meeting for parents of players in grades 7 & 8 who plan to play Traveling Basketball on Saturday, December 11 at 8:15 AM at Wausau East.** This too, is a Junior Jax Saturday date. I am anticipating that the meeting will take approximately 30 minutes to go over needed information and answer questions.

Please make sure to include at least one e-mail address (*more if you would like*) on the enclosed registration form, as I would like to be able to communicate a variety of information as it pertains to Lumberjack Basketball over the course of the season.

I ask that you make every effort to return the form to me by the listed due date (**October 15**), as that will give me ample time to put together e-mail groups, order T-shirts and get other important information to you in a timely manner. The first Junior Jax Saturday is November 6<sup>th</sup> @ Wausau East from 8 – 10 AM.

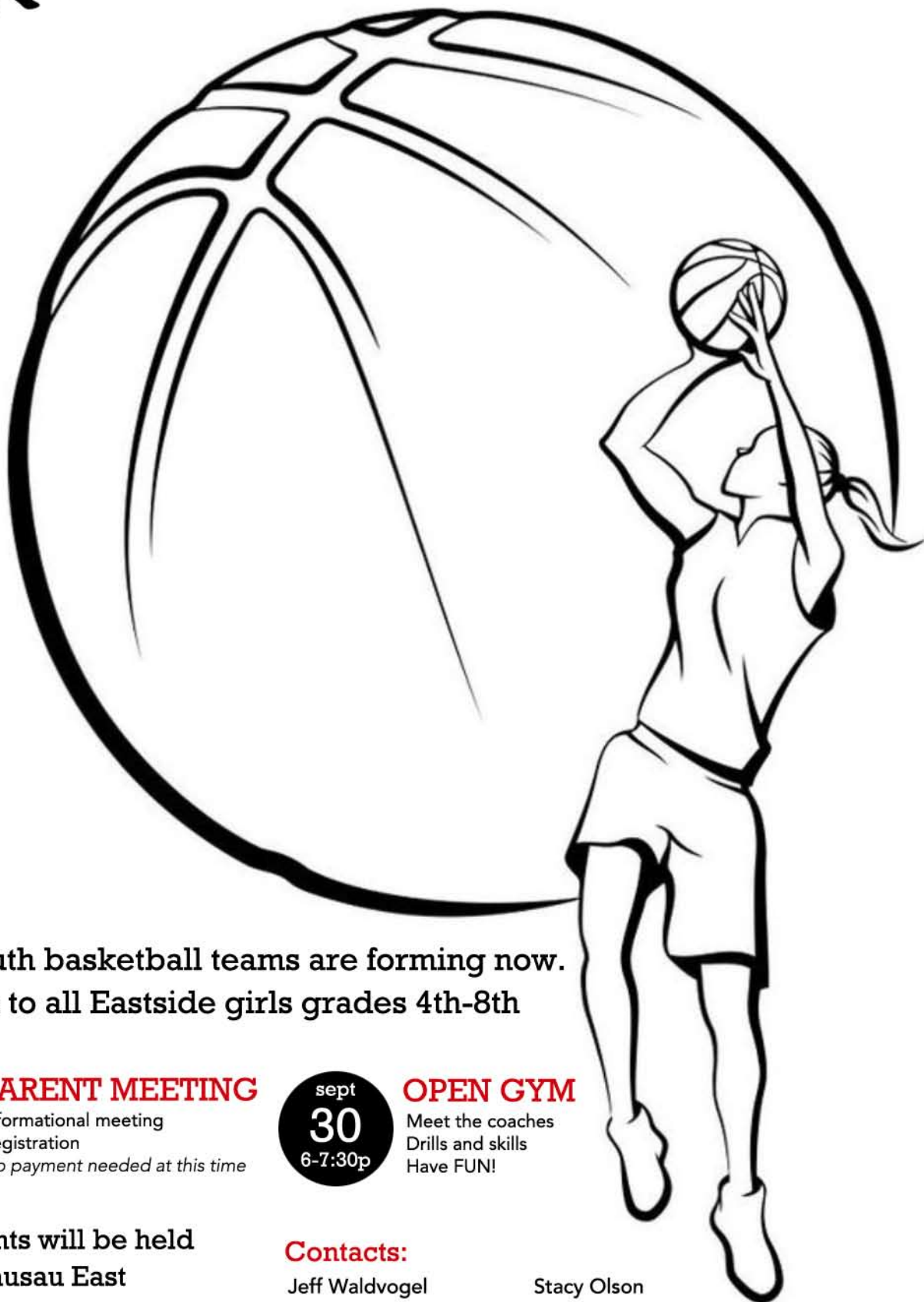
