The school improvement plan was discussed in depth. CMI training for teachers was discussed. Tammy the math coach discussed with Mrs. Arbon that 8 of 15 teachers have more than 1 year of training. Two full years are required for completion. It was decided that the teachers who wanted to would be able to finish. Lynn James is on the leadership team to help with this task.

The math goal will stay at 70% of students because it is an achievable goal for our students. Data will be collected from all year, because of COVID data was incomplete from previous year. On the math goal the wording was discussed that instead of stating 70% of students will achieve at or near mastery it now states students will achieve.

KEEP testing for kindergarten was not measured well.

Currently funding was provided for three math tutors, and the third paid position has not been filled yet.

There was discussion of a CANVAS stipend for teachers, depending on time put it. More information will be presented at next meeting.

Additional support is needed on the playground. Mr. Jolley on the playground has made a positive improvement. Julie Cook is also helping with safety in addition to her normal duties. It was discussed that a structured recess person may be needed. The kids are needing more a free play area. More equipment will be ordered to accomplish this goal.

Goal #4 on the school improvement plan is regarding a social emotional goal. A tigers den is almost complete for staff and students to practice calming strategies and feeling safe. Two aids to run the room would be needed. Heather Lancer, and Bailey would be great assets. It was discussed if this room would be good for asthma kids that can't be outside during recess.

HOPE squad is underway. There are posters and information posted around the school. It will roughly be 8-9 hours a month. Training for a coordinator is being completely, Heather Lancer.
