

TECH TIPS

GETTING STARTED WITH CANVAS & SKYWARD

Canvas vs. Skyward



During the 2020-2021 school year, SMSD added Canvas as the learning management system. In addition, students' grades and attendance are still tracked in Skwayrd. Both of these tools serve distinct purposes to inform parents about student grades, attendance, and learning.

Skyward



This is the student information system that keeps track of the details of each students' learning. Skyward also serves as the official grade book.

Within Skyward the parent can do the following:

- Check grades.
- Check attendance.
- Request updates for student information, emergency contacts, and other contact information.
- Change alerts to receive notifications about grades and attendance.
- The school administration may also post announcements or essential documents for parents and students in Skyward.

Canvas

Canvas is our learning management system, which ultimately is a digital version of students' classrooms.

Within Canvas the parent can do the following:

- View learning goals.
- View the standards of each course.
- View assignments.
- View announcements from individual teachers.
- Set up an observer account and see mostly all that students see.
- Organize all assignments and events into one calendar.



TRIBUTE DEADLINES

October 29 and December 10 are the two senior tribute deadlines. Payment is due by the deadline date to be accepted for pricing. Pictures and message for all tributes are due by December 10.

Tribute prices go up following the earlybird deadline, so turning in tribute information early is highly suggested.

Tribute prices listed on the second page reflect a 3.5% service charge for online purchases.

- We can not accept photos of children without clothing.
- We can not accept photos that have any sort of weapon related paraphernalia.
- Because of copyright, you must secure permission for one time use in Heritage, for any photos taken by a professional.
- We can not accept any song lyrics or poetry that you have not secured the copyright for.
- Heritage already has permission to use photos taken by Inter-State studios.
- If you do not want part of a photo to appear in your child's ad, or have other special instructions, please share a note detailing the requests via email to smsyearbookads@gmail.com.
- Heritage reserves the right to edit for content.
- A digital proof of your ad will be sent to the email address provided on the ad contract. Please contact T. Love or the Ads Managers if a proof has not been sent by February 16, 2022.
- You will be given one week from the date your proof is sent to provide feedback and request changes. After that period, all tributes will be considered final.

HOW TO PURCHASE

To purchase your senior tribute, please follow these instructions:

- Go to www.yearbookforever.com
- Search for Shawnee Mission South High School in the search bar.
- Select our school to navigate to the Walsworth SMS yearbook store.
- Click "Get Started" in the Create a Senior ad box.
- Provide the requested student information and buyer information to begin the purchase. Click "next" when ready.
- Click "Have the school design my ad".
- Select the tribute size you wish to purchase and click "next".
- Select color as your ad option and then click "continue".
- At this point you will be prompted to add senior tribute copy. In the "headline" box, please type your students name. In the "body" box, please provide the message you wish to have in your senior tribute.
- Click "next".
- You will be prompted to upload your photos. If you don't want photos in your tribute OR plan to bring in physical photos for scanning, please click on that option in the upper right hand corner of the screen.
- Click "next" to get to your shopping cart. You may continue shopping at this point or you can checkout.
- There is a % service fee on every senior tribute purchase
- Complete the purchase by checking out using your credit card information.
