Students must enroll with Total Registration AND the College Board. Students enrolled in an AP class at Paly should have already signed up with the College Board during class. **Students must sign up with the College Board (<https://myap.collegeboard.org/login>) AND Total Registration.**

Students NOT Enrolled in an AP Class at Paly: Students interested in taking an AP exam in which they are not enrolled in the class, must first sign up with Total Registration to find the appropriate join code. When signing up on Total Registration, sign up with “No Teacher.” After signing up with Total Registration, sign up with the College Board using “Exam Only.” Questions? Special Notes About AP Chinese: Due to capacity constraints, ALL students registering for the AP Chinese exam will automatically be waitlisted. PALY students enrolled in our AP Chinese class have first priority, followed by PALY students not enrolled in the course by grade level seniority.

You cannot take two tests at the same time, and PALY will decide which test you take first. For example, Seminar and Statistics. You will take one of them as a “Late Test.” Late Tests will be administered May 17-20. No extra fee is charged for schedule conflicts. Certain conflicts will incur a \$40 late testing exam fee. Free or Reduced Fees: Students who have a verifiable financial need are eligible for reduced fees. Please note that if eligible, fees are \$25/exam. See your Guidance Counselor for more information.

Testing with Accommodations: January 18 is the final day to submit a request for testing accommodations to the College Board. Work with your Guidance Counselor or Case Manager to submit a request, if necessary. If you are already approved by the College Board for accommodations, you do not need to refile. Please note that the request process can take seven weeks and does not begin until all required documentation is received.
