## TUITION AND OTHER COSTS

The Totino-Grace Board of Directors approves tuition and fees and releases the next year's tuition after the new calendar year.

### TUITION INCLUDES:

- Books and classroom materials (including art and industrial arts)
- Participation fees for athletics and activities with the exception of hockey and show choir
- Free student admission to all regular season sporting events, concerts, and plays held at Totino-Grace
- All professional guidance and special learning services
- On-campus parking

### AN ANNUAL TECHNOLOGY FEE COVERS:

- MacBook Air laptop and software
- Extended AppleCare coverage
- Spec protective case
- Laptop bag/carrying case
- Wi-Fi access
- On-site technology help desk and support
- Technical repairs and maintenance
- Annual updates

An annual re-enrollment fee is issued at the beginning of the calendar year.

## TUITION ASSISTANCE APPLICATION TIMELINE

Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS) is the company used by Totino-Grace to determine a family's level of financial need. TADS collects a variety of financial information, including income, assets, and expenses, to provide the Totino-Grace Tuition Assistance Committee with information that will assist with the distribution of available tuition assistance funds in the most equitable way possible. All families interested in applying for tuition assistance are **required to annually complete a TADS application**, which includes a \$45 processing fee. Only those directly involved in the tuition assistance decision-making process or in its administration are allowed to view TADS applications.

**October 1, 2021:** TADS application becomes available

**December 15, 2021:** TADS applications are due

**Week of February 1, 2022:** Tuition assistance grant notifications are issued for enrolled students

Please note that TADS applications received after **December 15, 2021**, will be subject to availability of remaining tuition assistance funds.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Totino-Grace High School annually awards 20+ merit scholarships to incoming ninth grade students. These scholarships are funded by generous donors who believe in the exceptional benefits of the transformative opportunities available to students at TG. Scholarship award recipients will be recognized at a special presentation ceremony in the spring. ### RACHEL WOELL INSPIRATION SCHOLARSHIP

Rachel Woell, the daughter of Jamie and Yvette Woell, was a highly involved and motivated TG student. She was known for her love for others and perseverance in the face of great personal adversity. Rachel passed away in September of 2014, her senior year at Totino-Grace, after a long battle with cancer. Her example inspired the TG community. Rachel's words, "Every day is a gift," have become one of TG's adopted mottos, one that shows respect and appreciation for life.

### BRIAN HARA LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

The Brian Hara Legacy Scholarship was established in 2019 to memorialize Brian and the impact he had on the world. Brian attended St. Odilia School from kindergarten through 8th grade and graduated from Totino-Grace in 2005. He excelled in academics and athletics, graduating with honors and winning multiple state championships. He later became a successful entrepreneur founding Blackhawk Investment Group. Brian was a compassionate humanitarian, a great leader, and a passionate student of life. He made the world a significantly better place and inspired others to do the same. This scholarship is open to eighth grade students at St. Odilia School.

### FOUR PILLARS SCHOLARSHIP

The Four Pillars Scholarship offered by Totino-Grace High School is one of the most prestigious awards that Totino-Grace can provide an incoming student. As a Catholic school in the Lasallian tradition, this scholarship recognizes Totino-Grace's four pillars of learning, faith, community, and service.

### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The International Student Scholarship is available to applicants who plan to reside in the On Campus Boarding Residence Center.

### TOTINO-GRACE ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Select students in the incoming ninth grade class will receive scholarships based on results from the HSPT Placement Exam, taken at Totino-Grace. A male and female who earn the: Top Comprehensive Exam Score, Top English Exam Score, Top Math Exam Score, and Top Science Exam Score will each be awarded this one-year, non-renewable scholarship.

# TUITION SUPPORT PROGRAMS

We strongly encourage families to explore and participate in assistance programs to aid with the cost of tuition. Many Totino-Grace families have paid for their entire tuition responsibility through these opportunities.

## STUDENT WORK STUDY

Enrolled students have the opportunity to participate in our on-campus, summer and academic year work study program. Students are required to complete an online application for summer and school year opportunities. Student work study income is applied to the student's tuition account; earnings are tax-free. Priority is given to students with financial need but work study is open to all students.

## TG EAGLE FOUNDATION

The Eagle Foundation offers families the opportunity to fundraise additional monies for student tuition accounts by volunteering at concessions for entertainment and local college and professional athletic events. The Eagle Foundation is open to anyone over age 16 and earnings are tax-free.

## SCRIP

Scrip fundraising, gift cards purchased through Totino-Grace, can be used for everyday purchases. Current and incoming families can earn tuition dollars via rebates from each purchase.

## THE FLAHERTY FAMILY FOUNDATION

Totino-Grace High School is proud of our strong partnership with the Flaherty Family Foundation which provides scholarships to high achieving students with economic need. Eighth grade student who meet specific criteria will be invited to complete an application. This scholarship opportunity offers more than dollars towards tuition; it includes academic support/ coaching, college and career readiness, and funding for summer enrichment activities. The scholarship can be annually renewed when the scholar/family meet the required conditions.
