INTRODUCTION

The Ron Sellnow Memorial Scholarship has been established in honor of Mr. Ron Sellnow. During his 25 year career as a math teacher and coach at Eisenhower, Lindbergh, and Hopkins High Schools, he motivated countless numbers of student-athletes, by leading hockey teams to the 1975 and 1980 State Tournaments and a soccer team to a State Championship Title in 1983. His impact on student success continued during his 10 year reign as Athletic Director, helping guide numerous teams to state tournament appearances along with state championships in Boys Cross Country, Boys Basketball, Women's Gymnastics, Girls/Boys Nordic Skiing, Girls Tennis, Softball, Dance Team, and Debate. After retiring from the school district in 1999, Ron continued working for and empowering student athletes through the State High School League and USA Hockey Camps until his death in 2012.

This scholarship is meant to honor Ron's legacy and the confidence he had in the potential of young people. He taught all of his athletes and students to consistently work as hard as they could while leading and positively influencing those around them. The scholarship committee is looking to reward student-athletes who excel in their respective sport (s), demonstrate their ability to overcome challenges and/or personal obstacles, and lead and inspire others to achieve success.

The scholarship committee will be awarding scholarships in the amount of \$2,000.00 to those students selected by the committee, as well as one female hockey player. The money awarded will be put towards their education and sent directly to the post-secondary institution of their choice.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Ron Sellnow Memorial Scholarship, students must:

1. be a senior in high school;
2. have a "B" (3.0) or better Grade Point Average
3. participate in a Hopkins High School-sponsored athletic activity
4. after graduation attend college or an equivalent school offering a post-secondary education
