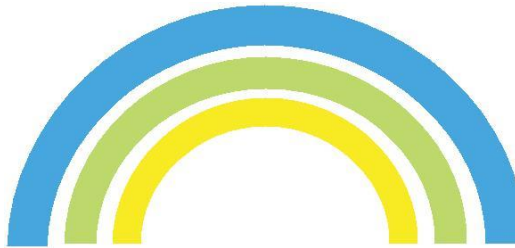

There are a limited number of American family homestays available to students ages 15 to 18, either for two weeks or one weekend. Host Families provide basic room and board and involvement as a member of the family, not as a formal guest. Students enjoy the homestay experience while learning about American culture, taking part in daily life and having ample opportunity to practice English.

Older students (ages 15 to 18) may also reside with a parent/guardian.

Participants are responsible for: International travel expenses to and from Hawaii, travel documents (visa, passport, etc.), health/accident insurance (required), daily transportation to and from school. Students will also be expected to bring sufficient spending money to cover personal expenses, emergency expenditures and any debts incurred while in the U.S.
