This will allow your child's tutor to provide specific feedback during your appointment. If you have an issue that requires a longer discussion, please contact Mrs Erroi (Head of Year 7) who will be able to assist you. We would like students to accompany parents, if possible, as they should ideally be at the heart of any discussion about their progress.
