
Our students benefit from a personalized education path, mentorship from professors and an amazing range of experiences inside and outside the classroom.





GRADUATE DEGREES

The Fisher College graduate degrees are grounded in the real world. Our flagship graduate degree, the Master of Business Administration in Strategic Leadership, offers two concentrations in Healthcare Management and Sport Administration, and is offered either as a 4+1 in-class degree or online. The 30 credit Master of Arts in Psychology, offered online, and 60-credit Master of Arts in Counseling Psychology, offered in a blended format or on-campus, can be completed within 2 years. The Master of Science in Criminal Justice is offered online, and our newest program, the Master of Science in Informatics, will be offered on-campus.






