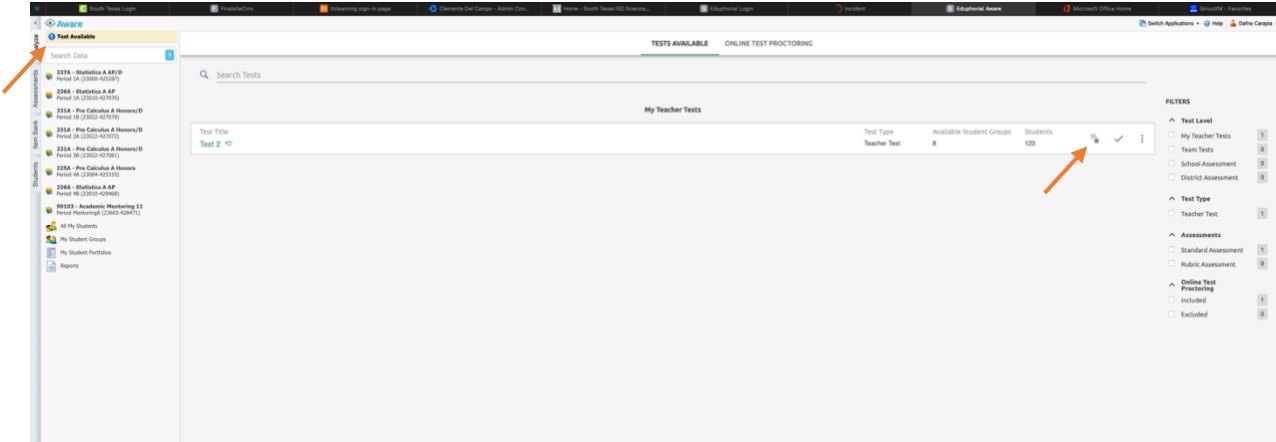
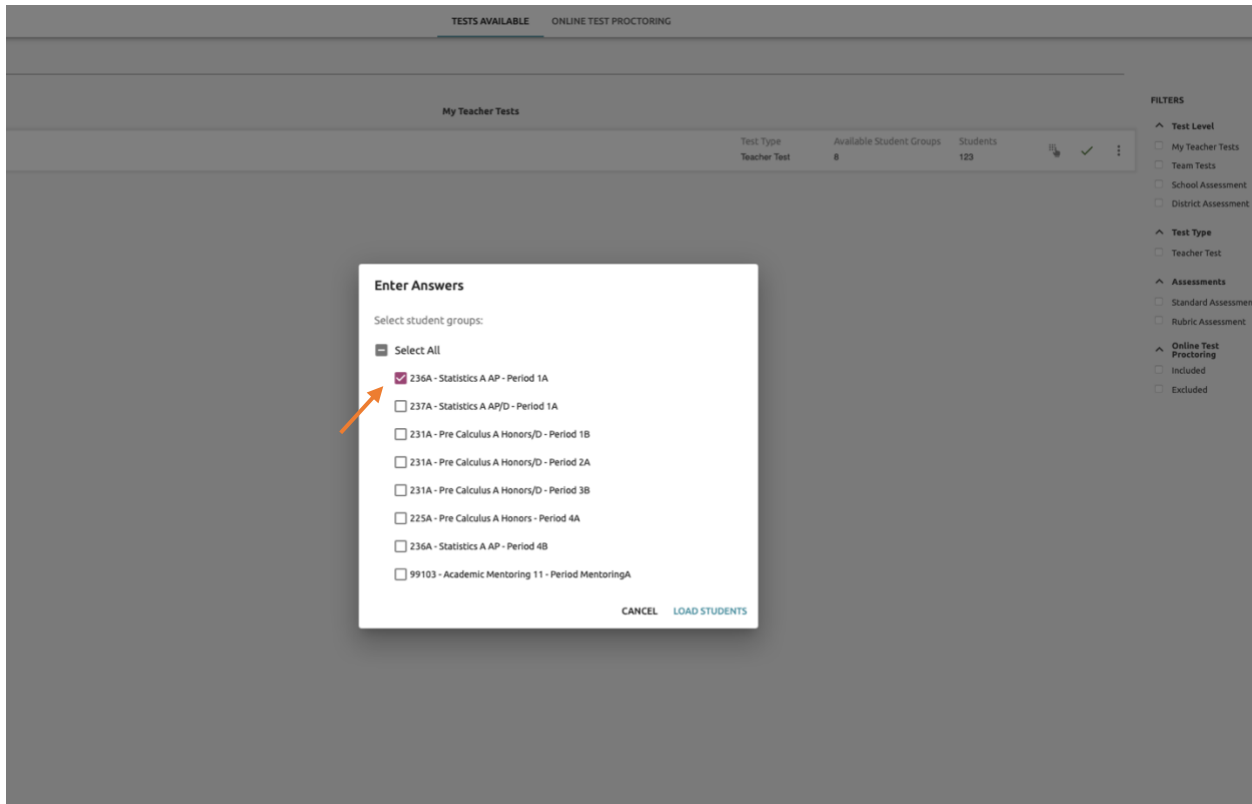


How to answer constructed response questions and see students results.

1. Under Analyze, click Test Available and select Enter Answers
